






MANUFACTURING ON THE SOUTH SHORE

A Critical Industry with High Employment Needs and High Wages Manufacturing represents one of the major employment sectors in the state, and with over 400 manufacturers calling the South Shore home, it remains one of the region's most critical industries.







In the Spring of 2018, the MassHire South Shore Workforce Board established the South Shore Manufacturing Advisory Group, including representatives from area manufacturers, educational institutions and industry associations who work collectively to address the industries' workforce needs.







- Manufacturing jobs require a higher skill level today than in the past, and wages have begun to reflect this specialization. Workers take home an average of \$20,000 more than the average non-manufacturing employee in MA.
- Wage growth of over 27% is expected in Massachusetts manufacturing over the next ten years.
- Massachusetts ranks among the highest states for production and innovation as result of the recent growth of manufacturing productivity, and the Commonwealth is investing over \$100 million in capital grants to support the Advanced Manufacturing Industry sector.
